A small star crocheted from cotton yarn

This Christmas star is crocheted from cotton yarn using a No. 3 crochet hook. It is approx. 6 cm high and approx. 6 cm wide. Attach a string for hanging at the top.

Star

- 1: 5 ch, assemble into a magic circle with a sl st in the first ch
- 2: 2 ch, 2 tr around the ch circle, *1 ch, 3 tr around the ch-sp*. Repeat from *-* 3 times, 1 ch, sl st in the ch at the top.
- 3: 2 ch, skip a stitch, 1 sl st, skip a stitch, 2 tr around the ch-sp, 1 ch, 2 tr around the ch-sp*. Repeat from *-* 4 times, sl st in the ch at the top.
- 4: *dc in the first 2 stitches, dc + htr + tr + htr + dcaround the ch-sp, 2 dc in the next 2 stitches, sl st in the previous round's sl st*. Repeat from *-* 4 times, sl st in the first dc of the round.

Cut and secure the ends.
Attach a string for hanging.
