## A crocheted doughnut

A crocheted doughnut measuring 6.5 cm in diameter. Crocheted using 8/4 cotton yarn and a 3.0 mm crochet hook. The sprinkle is embroidered with $8 / 4$ cotton yarn. The mouth is embroidered with Harmony embroidery floss. Wooden beads ( 5 mm diameter) are used for the eyes. The keyring with a snake chain is sewn on with $8 / 4$ cotton yarn.

## Doughnut:

## Use a 3.0 mm crochet hook.

1. Crochet 22 ch and make a magic circle with 1 sl st (22)
2. $1 \mathrm{ch}{ }^{*} 1 \mathrm{dc}, 2 \mathrm{dc}$ in the next st *. Repeat from * to * a total of 10 times, finish with dc (33)
3. 33 dc (33)
4. ${ }^{*} 2 \mathrm{dc}, 2 \mathrm{dc}$ in the next st *. Repeat from * to * a total of 10 times. Finish with dc (44)
5-11. 44 dc (44)
5.     * $2 \mathrm{dc}, 2 \mathrm{dc}$ together in the next st *. Repeat from * to * a total of 10 times. Finish with dc (33)
6. $33 \mathrm{dc}(\mathbf{3 3})$
7.     * $1 \mathrm{dc}, 2 \mathrm{dc}$ together in the next st *. Repeat from * to * a total of 10 times. Finish with dc (22)
8. 22 dc . Finish with sl st (22)

Bind off and leave the yarn long. The yarn end will be used for sewing the doughnut together.


## Fill with polyester wadding as you go along whilst sewing the

 doughnut together.
## lcing:

1. Crochet 22 ch and make a magic circle with 1 sl st (22)
2. 1 ch * $1 \mathrm{dc}, 2 \mathrm{dc}$ in the next st *. Repeat from * to * a total of 10 times, finish with dc (33)
3. 33 dc (33)
4. *2 dc, 2 dc in the next st *. Repeat from * to * a total of 10 times. Finish with dc (44)
5. $44 \mathrm{dc}(44)$
6. $1 \mathrm{dc}, 4 \mathrm{ch}, 1$ st ch is a turning chain (tch), 3 htr in the next $3 \mathrm{ch}, 1 \mathrm{sl}$ st in the next dc. $4 \mathrm{dc}, 6 \mathrm{ch}$, the 2 ch are turning chains (tch), 4 tr in the next $4 \mathrm{ch}, 1 \mathrm{sl}$ st in the fourth dc . $5 \mathrm{dc}, 4 \mathrm{ch}, 1$ st ch is a turning chain (tch), 3 htr in the next $3 \mathrm{ch}, 1 \mathrm{sl}$ st in the next dc . $4 \mathrm{dc}, 7 \mathrm{ch}$, the 2 ch are turning chains (tch), 5 tr in the next $5 \mathrm{ch}, 1 \mathrm{sl}$ st in the fourth dc. $2 \mathrm{dc}, 3 \mathrm{ch}, 1$ st ch is a turning chain (tch), 2 htr in the next $2 \mathrm{ch}, 1 \mathrm{sl}$ st in the next dc. $5 \mathrm{dc}, 5 \mathrm{ch}, 1$ st ch is a turning chain (tch), 4 tr in the next $4 \mathrm{ch}, 1$ sl st in the third dc . $3 \mathrm{dc}, 3 \mathrm{ch}, 1$ st ch is a turning chain (tch), 2 htr in the next $2 \mathrm{ch}, 1 \mathrm{sl}$ st in the next dc. 4 dc , finish with sl st, bind off.

Embroider sprinkles on the icing. Sew the icing onto the doughnut.

sl st = slip stitch
dc = double crochet
htr = half treble
tr = treble
