

Mini crocheted angel

Needle no. 3

- 1: mr of 6 dc **(6)**
- 2: *inc.* x 6 **(12)**
- 3: *1 dc, inc.* x 6 **(18)**
- 4: *inc., 2 dc* x 6 **(24)**
- 5: *2 dc, inc., 1 dc* x 6 **(30)**
- 6: *4 dc, inc.* x 6 **(36)**
- 7: Crochet in blo. Alternate between 1 dc and 1 bm. Start with dc. **(36)**
- 8: 35 dc, 1 bm **(36)**
- 9: Alternate between 1 dc and 1 bm. Start with dc. **(36)**

The rounds shift slightly. The next round starts from here and therefore does not follow the previous rounds.

- 10: Crochet in bm: *2 dc, dec., 2 dc* x 6 **(30)**
- 11: *dec., 3 dc* x 6 **(24)**
- 12: *1 dc, dec., 1 dc* x 6 **(18)**
- 13: *1 dc, dec.* x 6 **(12)**

Fill the body with teddy bear stuffing. Divide the chenille in half, then guide one of the halves through the magic ring.

- 14: *dec.* x 6 Cut the end of the yarn and close off around the chenille in the outermost stitch.

Abbreviations and symbols explanation

s = stitch

dc = double crochet

bm = bubble stitch (The stitch pops out like a bobble, unlike the original bubble stitch)

mr = magic ring

blo = Back loop only inc. = increase (2 stitches in the stitch)

dec. = decrease (2 double crochet stitches together)

- x ? = Repeat x number of times

(number) = number of stitches, which the round includes
