Yarn requirements:

2 colours x 15 g 8/4 cotton yarn

Crochet hook no. 3, 3 g stuffing, 1 squeaker

Abbreviations and symbol explanations

dc = double crochet

st = stich

ch = chain stitch

* = repeat from * to * for the whole the round

1. Make a magic ring with 6 double crochet stitches in colour 1. [▶ Technique 2+3](#)
2. 2 dc in every st all around (12)
3. *1 dc, 2 dc in next st*, repeat all around (18)
4. *2 dc, 2 dc in next st*, repeat all around (24)
5. 24 dc around
6. 24 dc around
7. 24 dc around
8. 24 dc around
9. Crochet decrease *2 dc, 2 dc together* all around (18) [▶ Technique 4](#)
Cut the yarn and crochet another end 'ball' as described above, but do not cut the yarn and go to no. 10.
10. Now take the first end and crochet 3 dc through both 'balls'.
Continue with 2 dc together on the first 'ball', 11 dc, 2 dc together, 2 dc together on the other 'ball', 11 dc, 2 dc together. (26)
11. Switch the yarn colour and crochet 11 double crochet stitches, 2 double crochet stitches together, 11 double crochet stitches, 2 double crochet stitches together. Crochet another 3 rows with this colour (24 stitches).
12. Alternately crochet 3 rows of colour 1 and 4 rows of colour 2 with 24 double crochet stitches in each row for a total of 7 stripes. Stop before the last row in the last stripe and make a crochet increase as described in no. 13. Note: Because you are crocheting in a spiral, the start of each round will shift. So, you can move the start of the round by 1 sc to the right every time you change colour. The increases will then continue in the middle of the back of the bone. Add the filling as you crochet and if desired, use a squeaker. Locate the centre of the dog bone in a straight line up from the centre of the one end. If you accidentally flip the start of the round, the ends will turn in relation to each other.
13. 1 dc (first st on round, mark stitch), 2 dc in next st, 9 dc, 2 dc in next st, 1 dc (13th st on round), 2 dc in next st, 9 dc, 2 dc in last st. (28)
14. Now divide the work into the two 'balls'.
15. Switch the yarn colour and make 3 chain stitches, 2 double crochet stitches in the marked stitch opposite, 11 double crochet stitches, 2 double crochet stitches in the next stitch. (18) [▶ Technique 1](#)

16. In the 3 ch, crochet 3 dc. Crochet increase *2 dc in next st, 2 dc* 5 times. Finish with 1 dc, 2 dc in last st of round. (24)
17. 24 dc around
18. 24 dc around
19. 24 dc around
20. 24 dc around
21. *2 dc, 2 dc together*, repeat all around (18)
22. *1 dc, 2 dc together*, repeat all around (12)
23. Decrease *2 dc together* all around. (6)
24. Cut and pull the last 6 dc together, fasten off the end.
25. Now crochet the final 'ball'. Start the round at 3 ch, 2 dc in the same st, crochet 13 dc. (18)
26. Crochet increase *2 dc, 2 dc in next st* all around. (24)
27. 24 dc around
28. 24 dc around
29. 24 dc around
30. 24 dc around
31. *2 dc, 2 dc together*, repeat all around (18)
32. *1 dc, 2 dc together*, repeat all around (12)
33. Decrease *2 dc together* all around. (6)

Cut and pull the last 6 dc together, fasten off the end. Finished size approx. 16 cm.
