

Crocheted Easter Eggs

Yarn: 8/4 cotton yarn.
Use two colours to make stripes.

Crochet hook: 3 mm.

Abbreviations and symbol explanations

- dc = double crochet
* = repeat from * to * for the whole the round

Large H: 5 cm (3 g yarn & 1 g filling)

1. Make a magic ring with 5 dc [Technique 1](#)
2. 2 dc in every stitch all around (10 stitches) [Technique 2](#)
3. *1 dc, 2 dc in the next stitch*, repeat all around (15 stitches)
4. 1 dc in every stitch all around (15 stitches)
5. 1 dc in the next 4 stitches, 2 dc in the next stitch, repeat all around (18 stitches)
6. 1 dc in every stitch all around (18 stitches)
7. 1 dc in the next 2 stitches, 2 dc in the next stitch. *1 dc in the next 5 stitches, 2 dc in the next 3 stitches (21 stitches)
8. 1 dc in every stitch all around (21 stitches)
9. 1 dc in every stitch all around (21 stitches)
10. *1 dc in the next 6 stitches, 2 dc in the next stitch*, repeat *-* x 3 (24 stitches)
11. 1 dc in every stitch all around (24 stitches)
12. 1 dc in every stitch all around (24 stitches)
13. *1 dc in the next 6 stitches, 2 dc together*, repeat *-* x 3 (21 stitches) [Technique 3](#)
14. 1 dc in next 3 stitches. 2 dc together*1 dc in the next 5 stitches, 2 dc together*, repeat *-* 1 dc in the next 2 stitches (18 stitches)
15. * 1 dc in the next 4 stitches, 2 dc together*, repeat *-* x 3 (15 stitches)

Fill with polyester filling.

16. 1 dc * 2 dc together*, repeat *-* five times (10 stitches)

Add filling

Cut the yarn to approx. 15 cm. Close and weave the end of the yarn into the 10 stitches and close the hole by pulling the end of the yarn. [Technique 4](#)

Make an 8 cm ring for hanging and fasten off the end of the yarn.

Shape the egg with your hands.

Small

H: 3.5 cm (1 g yarn & ½ g filling)

1. Make a magic ring with 5 dc [Technique 1](#)
2. 2 dc in every stitch all around (10 stitches) [Technique 2](#)
3. *1 dc, 2 dc in the next stitch*, repeat all around (15 stitches)
4. 1 dc in every stitch all around (15 stitches)
5. 1 dc in the next 4 stitches, 2 dc in the next stitch, repeat all around (18 stitches)
6. 1 dc in the next 2 stitches, 2 dc in the next stitch. *1 dc in the next 5 stitches, 2 dc in the next stitch*, repeat *-*, 1 dc in the next 3 stitches (21 stitches)
7. 1 dc in every stitch all around (21 stitches)
8. *1 dc in the next 6 stitches, 2 dc in the next stitch*, repeat *-* x 3 (24 stitches)
9. *1 dc in the next 6 stitches, 2 dc together*, repeat *-* x 3 (21 stitches) [Technique 3](#)
10. 1 dc in next 3 stitches. 2 dc together*1 dc in the next 5 stitches, 2 dc together*, repeat *-* 1 dc in the next 2 stitches (18 stitches)
11. *1 dc in the next 4 stitches, 2 dc together*, repeat *-* x 3 (15 stitches)

Fill with polyester filling.

12. 1 dc * 2 dc together*, repeat *-* five times (10 stitches)

Add filling

Cut the yarn to approx. 15 cm. Close and weave the end of the yarn into the 10 stitches and close the hole by pulling the end of the yarn. [Technique 4](#)

Make a H.8 cm ring for hanging and fasten off the end of the yarn.

Shape the egg with your hands.
